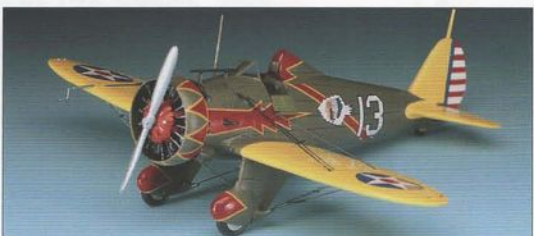

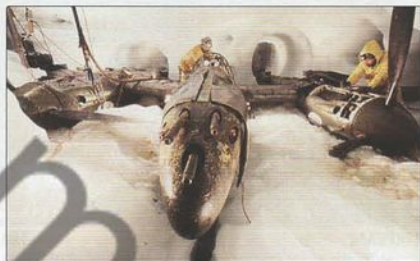

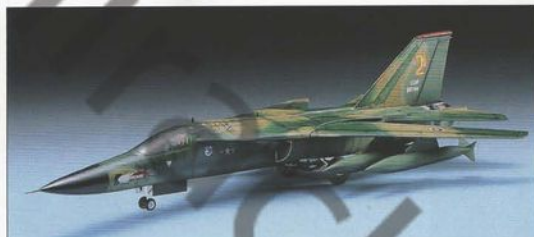

The first of the F-111 series, this jet was designed as a carrier-based plane with the ability to be refitted for other operations.

1647**1/48 FB-111A AARDVARK**

This version of the F-111 series jet was built as a strategic bomber to replace the obsolete B-52 and B-58 bombers.

1648**1/48 F-14A TOMCAT**

The U.S. Navy's premier carrier-based fighter, the F-14A Tomcat is capable of Mach 2 flight and low-speed engagements thanks to its variable-geometry wings.

1659**1/48 F-111C AARDVARK**

24 of these fighters were supplied to the Royal Australian Air Force to be used specifically in Australia. This version of the F-111 featured a longer wing span and strengthened landing gear.

1674**1/48 F-111F AARDVARK**

The pride of the U.S. Air Force, this F-111 is said to be the best tactical fighter in the series.

1675**1/48 F-111A RAVEN**

The last version of the F-111 series, this converted fighter was constructed to accommodate tactical air command or to be a flying radar station.

1676**1/48 F-15C/D EAGLE**

This version of the F-15 series was built as an air-to-air combat fighter.

1685**1/48 F-15E STRIKE EAGLE**

Designed specifically to be a superior fighter jet, this plane carries an astounding array of air-to-air and air-to-ground weapons.

1687**1/48 F-16A/C FIGHTING FALCON**

A single-seat fighter, this lightweight jet is one of the United States' best air-to-air combat fighters.

12101**1/48 F-111E STRIKE BOMBER**

A later version in the F-111 series, this strike bomber featured larger air intakes to accommodate its larger TF30-P-3 engines.

1689**1/48 F-16C FIGHTING FALCON FOR DEMONSTRATION**

Because of its excellent maneuverability at high speeds, the Fighting Falcon was chosen for the aerial acrobatics of the Thunderbirds.

1695**1/48 MIG-29A FULCRUM A**

This supersonic air superiority and ground attack fighter, first flew in 1985 and shares many similarities with the American F/A-18 Hornet.

2116**1/48 F-15E STRIKE EAGLE W/ WEAPONS**

This air-to-ground fighter was designed to carry a heavy payload of weapons and provide tactical support to front-line infantry columns.

**1/48 F-117A STEALTH FIGHTER**

The unusual design of the F-117A allows for almost complete radar invisibility, enabling this plane to fly undetected over enemy positions.

2118**1/48 MIG-29UB FULCRUM B**

This two seat trainer version of the MiG-29A jet was dubbed the "Fulcrum B" by NATO.

2119**1/48 SU-27 FLANKER B**

The Sukhoi SU-27 was designed as a long-range interceptor to replace the outdated MiG-23.

2131**1/48 SU-27UB FLANKER C**

The SU-27UB, designated the "Flanker C" by NATO, was a two-seat trainer version of the original SU-27.

2140**1/48 HAWKER HUNTER F.6**

Designed to replace the Gloster Meteor as the air defense weapon of choice for the Royal Air Force, the Hunter boasted "dog-tooth" leading edges for greater range.

2164**1/48 MIG-21PF FISHBED-D**

An all-weather fighter designed for air superiority, this MiG was once the most widely used aircraft in the world.

2168**1/48 HAWKER HUNTER FGA.9**

The British FGA.9 was a ground attack version of the subsonic Hawker Hunter, first flown in 1951.

2169**1/48 MIG-21MF FISHBED-J**

A high-performance air-to-air interceptor used by the USSR Air Defense.

2171**1/48 T-33A SHOOTING STAR**

The U.S. Air Force used the Shooting Star as a standard Jet trainer in the 1950s.

2185**1/48 F-16C FIGHTING FALCON 'FLYING RAZORBACKS'**

A single-seat fighter, this lightweight jet is one of the United States' best air-to-air combat fighters.

**1/48 AH-64A APACHE****2115**

This highly agile and well-armed U.S. Army attack helicopter, first flown in 1974, saw extensive action in both Operation Just Cause in Panama and Operation Desert Storm in the Middle East.

The Longbow is a fully updated version of the AH-64 Apache including the highly advanced Longbow/Hellfire target acquisition system.

The most successful British fighter plane of World War I, this dogfighter was renowned for shooting down German Ace Rittmeister Manfred von Richthofen, the "Red Baron."

A fast-climbing and agile fighter of World War I that earned William Avery Bishop the second highest-scoring British and Empire pilot in 1917.

During the Korean war, these were the first helicopters to be used to evacuate the wounded.

**1/35 OH-58D KIOWA WARRIOR 'BLACK DEATH'****2195**

In Operation Desert Storm, these helicopters were nicknamed "Black Death" by the Iraqis.

The Direct Action Penetrator (DAP) is one of the most awesome airborne weapon platforms operated by the US Army's Special Operation Forces.

Used during Vietnam, this UH-1C was armed with grenade launchers, rocket pods and M-60 machine guns.

Used by the U.S. Coast Guard for border patrol and rescues.

This cranked-wing dive-bomber, initially flown in 1935, and ground attack aircraft lasted through World War II.

**1/72 TBF-1 AVENGER****1651**

Designed as a torpedo bomber, the Avenger's speed and performance made it a constant threat to enemy ships during World War II.

**1/72 CURTISS P-40B TOMAHAWK****1655**

Before the U.S. entered World War II, many American pilots flew these planes in support of the Allied war effort. Collectively they were known as the "Flying Tigers" for their unique paint schemes.

**1/72 FOCKE-WULF FW190D****1660**

The cantilever low-wing Focke-Wulf was powered by a liquid-cooled Junkers Jumo engine and served as one of the Luftwaffe's major airplanes during World War II.

**1/72 T-66 TEXAN****1662**

Originally designed in 1938 as a trainer, the Texan served as a surveying plane during the Korean War and is still flown today as a trainer in some countries.

**1/72 F4F-4 WILDCAT****1650**

The Wildcat began service with the U.S. Navy shortly before the Japanese bombed Pearl Harbor in December of 1941 and saw extensive action in the Pacific.

**1/72 MESSERSCHMITT Bf109G-14****1653**

The Bf 109, which first saw action in 1937 during the Spanish Civil War, went on to become one of the Luftwaffe's most important aircraft.

**1/72 F4U-1 CORSAIR****1657**

The F4U-1 Corsair was nicknamed "Whistling Death" by the enemy due to the fear the engine sound inspired as the plane approached.

**1/72 FI-156 STORCH / MORANE SAULNIER MS 500/502****1661**

An Fi-156 Storch made the daring rescue of Benito Mussolini from an Italian stronghold high in the Alps.

**1/72 HAWKER TYPHOON MK.IB****1664**

The Typhoon was well-suited for low-level attacks on shipping and armored divisions thanks to its twin mounted 20mm cannons and capability of carrying eight 60lb rockets.

**1/72 P-51B MUSTANG**

Widely used by the American and British forces, the Mustang was closely suited for tactical reconnaissance and its standard four 12.7mm machine-guns meant that it also had potential for ground attack.

1667**1/72 P-40M/N WARHAWK**

Rugged and reliable, the P-40 was used in every theater of World War II by the Royal Air Force and U.S. Air Force.

1668**1/72 HAWKER TEMPEST V**

An elaboration of the Hawker Typhoon, the Tempest featured elliptical wings, allowing for higher airspeed and lower compressibility.

1669**1/72 MESSERSCHMITT BF109G-6**

The Bf 109, which first saw action in 1937 during the Spanish Civil War and went on to become one of the Luftwaffe's most important aircraft.

1670**1/72 P-40E WARHAWK**

Rugged and reliable, the P-40 was used in every theater of World War II by the Royal Air Force and U.S. Air Force.

1671**1/72 Me-163B/S KOMET**

Powered by a Walter rocket motor, the Komet was capable of climbing at a rate of 11,800ft per minute. However, due to its late introduction in 1945, it had little impact on the war.

1/72 F6F-3/5 HELLCAT**2121**

A carrier-based fighter, the Hellcat played an instrumental role in the Pacific theater achieving a major victory for the Allies in the Battle for the Philippine Sea.

**1/72 PBV-5 CATALINA****2123**

An updated version of the PBV-2, this amphibious airplane featured retractable landing gear.

**1/72 HAWKER HURRICANE MK.IIC****2129**

The lesser-known Hawker Hurricane, first flown in 1937, gained fame by fighting alongside the Supermarine Spitfire during the Battle of Britain.

**1/72 SPITFIRE MK.XIVC****2130**

The MK.XIVC model of the British workhorse Spitfire plane featured a strengthened airframe designed to hold the weight of a larger engine and five-blade propeller.

**1/72 P-51D MUSTANG****2132**

The P-51D was the major production version of the Mustang, equipped with a bubble canopy and six 12.7mm machine guns.

**1/72 MESSERSCHMITT BF109E-3/4****2133**

The Bf109 fighter planes played a major role in the Luftwaffe's attack on Poland that marked the beginning of World War II.

**1/72 PBV-4 CATALINA****2136**

The PBV-4 was America's most successful seaplane during World War II.

**1/72 PBV-5A BLACK CAT****2137**

The U.S. navy favored the PBV-5A's amphibious design over the preceding PBV-5.

**1/72 P-47D THUNDERBOLT 'BUBBLE-TOP'**

This P-47's unique canopy gave the pilot a full 360° view of the surrounding skies.

2174**1/72 P-47D THUNDERBOLT 'RAZOR-BACK'**

Originally criticized for its size and weight, this older P-47 was called the "Razorback" because of its narrow, curving top line.

2175**1/72 ZERO FIGHTER TYPE 52C (AGM5C)**

Designed to counter the superior Allied air forces, the 52C was the heavy armed version of the famous Zero fighter, which was eventually used in the feared kamikaze attacks.

2176**1/72 P-39G/N AIRACOBRA**

The P-39 was developed for the U.S. Army with the intention of creating a plane with increased forward firepower during World War II.

2177**1/72 F-51D MUSTANG 'KOREAN WAR' with GROUND VEHICLE**

This fighter was a favorite of the ROKAF during the Korean War.

2205**1/72 P-38J LIGHTNING 'PACIFIC THEATER'**

A World War II juggernaut, the P-38's responsibilities included everything from low-level attacks to photographic reconnaissance.

2209**1/72 FI-156 STORCH 'AFRIKA KORPS' with KÜBELWAGEN**

Famous light reconnaissance plane during World War II.

2212**1/72 FOCKEWULF FW190A-8 'Heinz Bär' with KÜBELWAGEN**

Although slated to never achieve the same success as the Messerschmitt, the Focke-Wulf would prove to be one of the greatest fighters of World War II.

2213**1/72 MESSERSCHMITT BF109E-3/4 'Heinz Bär' with KETTENKRAD**

The Bf 109 fighter planes played a major role in the Luftwaffe's attack on Poland that marked the beginning of World War II.

2214**1/72 P-39N AIRACOBRA 'RUSSIAN ACE'**

The P-39 was developed for the U.S. Army with the intention of creating a plane with increased forward firepower during World War II.

P-51 Mustang "Allison Engine" version was used by the U.S. Army Air Corps in early WWII.

A World War II juggernaut, the P-38's responsibilities included everything from low-level attacks to photographic reconnaissance.

This bomber, first flown in 1939, was superior to its predecessor, the Y1B-17A, in that the new model had turbo engines.

The B-29A's three pressurized cabins eliminated the need for Superfortress crews to wear 75 lbs. of insulated clothing to prevent frostbite.

**1/72 B-50 SUPERFORTRESS****2112**

A later elaboration of the B-29, the B-50 saw most of its service during the Korean War. With a possible payload of over 10,000kg it leaves its predecessor by the wayside.

**1/72 KB-29 TANKER****2113**

"Gas stations" of the sky, these converted Boeing B-29's deliver much needed gasoline payloads to planes during long range missions.

**1/72 RAF B-17E FLYING FORTRESS****2141**

The famed "fortress of the sky," these planes were capable of lending off attacking planes and bombing targets deep within enemy territory.

**1/72 B-17F FLYING FORTRESS****2142**

An updated version of the B-17E, this plane featured a rear-mounted gun for defense of what had been the Flying Fortress' blind spot.

Another elaboration of the B-17 design, the G sported a chin-mounted turret to fend off oncoming attackers.

The B-17D was outfitted with more powerful engine, cowl flaps, and space for an additional crewmember over the B-17C. This kit includes markings for Captain Collin P. Kelly's B-17C.

The famed "Enola Gay" Superfortress boasted one of the most awesome weapon payloads of World War II.

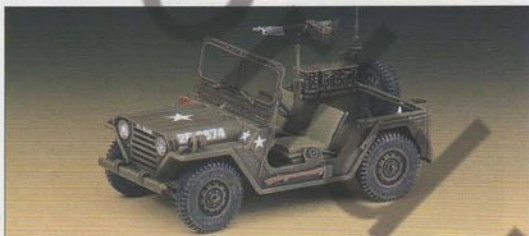

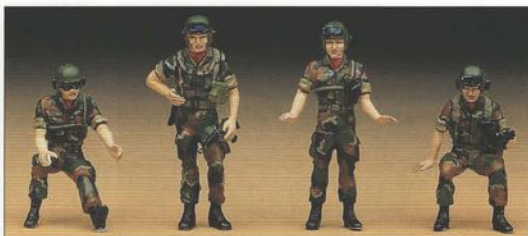

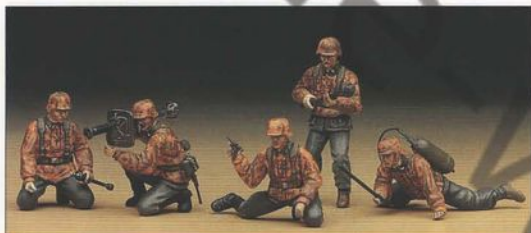
