During the operation he became known as the "Candy Bomber" because he repeatedly dropped candy attached to little parachutes to German children from his aircraft on approach to the runways at Berlin's Tempelhof Airport.

The MATS Connie, also known as a C-121A, was delivered to the U.S. Air Force Military Air Transport Service in 1948. In addition to her Berlin airlift participation, the MATS Connie worked as a VIP transport, accumulating 16,000 hours of flying time during her Air Force career. **14540**



1/144 National Airlines DC-4

Originally built in 1938, the DC-4 soon saw its transformation into the famous C-54 military transport when the U.S. entered WW II. National Airlines began in 1937 as National Airlines System. Their DC4s were introduced in 1946. Authentic civilian markings. Striking retro packaging.
