
Armor

Building and painting scale models of historic armor weapons and vehicles is a unique hobby with many military enthusiasts. A skilled hobbyist can paint a 1/35 scale figure in lifelike realism including detailed facial features and uniform insignia. Tanks and other vehicles can be weathered and "battle-torn" to make them look authentic. Many military modelers will spend countless hours in research to get the proper historic background for the models they build, to be sure that all the details are accurate. Historic reference material also provides suggestions for building the assembled model into a diorama, which may often be a reproduction of an actual situation. Monogram kits are favorites of armor enthusiasts because of the highly realistic details in the models.

DIORAMAS

Creating dioramas for displaying models has become a popular extension of the model building hobby. Monogram kits are highly detailed, and the assembled model can be painted with a "weathered" appearance and mounted in an appropriate setting with artificial landscaping and "battle-scarred" structures.

MODEL BUILDING TIPS

Although model building procedures vary from one hobbyist to another, certain basic guidelines have been established over the years. It is well for the advanced model builder as well as the beginner to watch the hobby magazines for articles that may offer tips on new methods and techniques or introduce new tools or hobby materials.




Above all, you should remember three very important suggestions:

- 1: Keep your work area clean. Lay newspapers down before you begin, to avoid marring the table top with stray cement, paint or decal scraps. Keep unneeded material out of your way. Keep your tools organized and keep plastic parts in order.
- Follow the instructions. Read the instruction sheet thoroughly and study the illustrations before you begin. Then follow each step in order as you assemble your model.
- 3. Start out with the finest model kits available. Monogram kits are engineered with precision detail for parts that fit, produced with high standards of quality and molded in colors appropriate for the item.

For successful model building, there are other tips to keep in mind.

- Read painting suggestions before assembly. Some parts should be painted before cementing.
- Do not remove parts from "trees" until ready for use. Each part is identified by a number. If some of the smaller parts are to be painted, they are sometimes easier to paint while they are still attached to the tree.
- CUT parts from trees, preferably with small diagonal cutters or a razor knife Breaking off may damage a part. Be sure to cut, scrape or file excess plastic from parts at the point where they were joined to the tree.



- Apply cement with a toothpick on small areas. Very little cement is needed to hold parts together. Too much cement can damage your model.
- Scrape plating from plastic parts where they require cementing. This is an important step which should not be neglected. Cement will NOT stick to plating. On small parts, the plating can be removed while the part is still attached to the tree.
- Don't rush. Take time to enjoy your hobby, and to do a careful, thorough job.
 Be sure to allow time for cement and paint to dry between steps.

What tools do you need?

Certain tools have become standard in model building, but with experience, hobbyists usually develop their individual preferences beyond these recommendations. The tools that should be available include a hobby-craft knife, two or three small Swiss files, very fine sandpaper, two or three fine-pointed brushes plus a wider brush for painting larger areas, small scissors, tube of cement or liquid cement, spring clothespins, tweezers, and transparent tape for masking. Plastic model paints are available in small bottles or in spray cans. Toothpicks should also be kept handy.
